WHY?

- Founded in 1962, we are one of the oldest 2CV clubs in the world, it's time to celebrate our first 50 years!
- We want to invite YOU to party in a unique meeting site right in the middle of the best Finnish nature.
- Finland has a long tradition of organising international 2CV events: 1st International Meeting of 2CV Friends in 1975, 10th World Meeting in 1993, 10 x Raid Laponie, 3 x Raid Mosquito... We also publish the international 2CV road service booklet APUA-HELP since 1975 - the next one will be out in 2012 for the jubilee.

WHERE?

- SULKAVA is ideally situated in the Southern part of Finland among thousands of beautiful lakes and islands.
- SÄTKÄLÄ (= 2CV village) is our private meeting site with a natural lakeshore. The needed basic infrastructure is there including of course two saunas near the waters edge. You can even enter the meeting with a floating 2CV.
- We expect around 300 2CVs to participate in this human-scale 2CV meeting in the spirit of good old times: "Back to the roots of 2CV Friends" with games and a good time together with friends from all over.
- Find your own spot in the unique forest camping right next to the Jubilee area. You can also choose indoor accommodation from the several alternatives within 5-10 km, maybe a lakeside log cottage for example.

WHAT WILL WE DO THERE?

- We will offer a versatile meeting program to fit our "back to roots" theme. Some highlights and examples: funny games, 2CV beauty competition, challenges like 2CV water-ski, blues & roots music, 2CV song competition, joy & fun for kids, too.
- Other activities can include boating, canoing, fishing, bicycling, hiking, swimming; lots to see and experience in the surroundings and the unique wilderness...

HOW TO COME TO FINLAND?

- Many ways lead to Finland. Easiest take a ferry directly from Germany or Poland to Helsinki. Many people prefer the road through Denmark and Sweden (and then a ferry to Southern Finland). The route through the Baltic countries may be the most economical alternative.

ARE THERE RAIDS TO PARTICIPATE?

- We are planning a guided raid to Finland starting from a Middle-European location.
- A "slow-raid" approaching from South-Western Finland will be available.
- After the meeting, we arrange the 4th Raid Mosquito to Lapland with opportunity to reach the North Cape, if you like.

DO WE FREEZE AND CAN I SEE THE MIDNIGHT SUN?

- The weather in summertime is not much different from Central European weather (winter is different). The daytime temperatures can be anything from 15 to 30C.
- It does not get completely dark even at night although midnight sun only can be seen in Lapland at this time of the year.

HOW TO MAKE A PRE-INSRIPTION ?

We want to make this meeting an affordable one for you. Make your inscription at our website www.2cv.fi/50. The fee for a 2CV is 30 eur which will cover the participation and camping at the meeting for a maximum of 4 persons. As a pre-inscription benefit you will receive a personal "voucher" (worth 15 eur) which you can use during the event to purchase one meeting t-shirt. This offer is valid for a limited time!
